Each grade has a specific list of supplies they give every child to bring on the first day of school. As an example, here is a list required for a student going into the third grade.

3 single-subject notebooks with holes	Scissors
3 two-pocket folder with holes	2 glue sticks
1 2-inch 3-ring binder	1 Yellow highlighter
1 black and white composition notebook	24 pack of crayons (no larger)
Number 2 wooden pencils (4 to start)	1 Small art box
2 Red pens	2 Packages of 3" by 5" note cards
2 Dark colored dry erase markers and old sock to use as an eraser	Colored pencils (Optional)
Tissues	Clorox or Lysol sanitizing wipes
Zip-Lock baggies (any size)	Hand sanitizer

Keep in mind as you are reading this that we help students from kindergarten through high school. And YES, even some college students! Other items for higher grades are: ink pens, protractors, compass, binders, algebraic calculators, subject separators, book covers, loose leaf notebook paper (college and wide ruled), and pencil bags.
